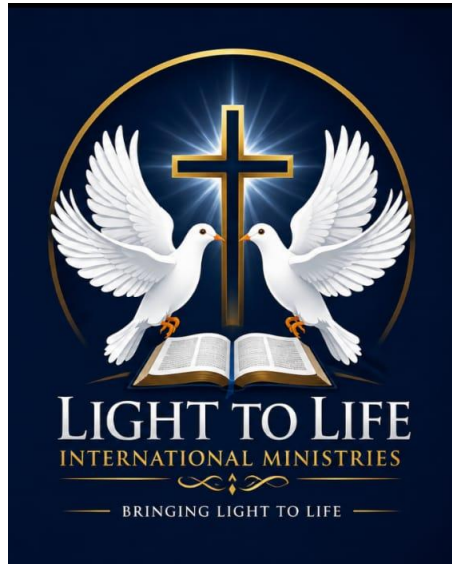

PROJECT 1: CHILDREN'S HOME EXPANSION

Funding Required: USD \$150,000
